- Each site coordinator remains at one school for the entire school year
- Site Coordinators provide direct services to students, families and staff that may include:
 - Individual counseling, group counseling, family counseling, crisis intervention, psychoeducational presentations, referrals and case management, behavior interventions, behavior plans, resource gathering and school wide services
